Box 1739, Salisbury, Maryland has applied to construct an electrical feeder line by horizontal directional drilling an 18-inch diameter bore hole and placing one 10-inch conduit with three electrical cables and one neutral cable approximately 655 linear under the tidal waters of Cox Creek at a minimum depth of 25 feet below the bottom substrate. The purpose of this project is to improve electrical service in the area. The proposed project is located below Cox Creek in the area of Thompson Creek Road, and Fair Prospect Farm Court in Stevensville, Maryland to Harbor Drive, Chester, Maryland.
