Joint Meeting of the Police Accountability Board and the Administrative Charging Committee

Meeting Minutes for April 12, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Karl Milligan at 4:00 pm.

Present were PAB board members Douglas Womack, Bernard Sadusky, William Comegys, Janet Pauls, James W. Thompson and Chair Karl Milligan. Mr. Pete Eladis had an excused absence.

ACC members present were Chair Milligan, Connie Loureiro Jane Vezeris and Tom Beery. Mr. Wayne Darell was absent. Also attending was PAB Board Administrator Lance Richardson and Todd Mohn, County Administrator.

- Chair Milligan asked everyone to introduce themselves.
- Several announcements followed:
 - The County Commissioners have approved a stipend for both the Board and Committee.
 - The PAB Board will meet quarterly and be responsible for police policy recommendations and reports.
 - The ACC will meet monthly and be responsible for complaint reviews and recommendations to police agencies.
- Chair Milligan advised that four members of the ACC had completed the required training, consisting of forty hours over five days. It was conducted by the MPCTC in Denton, Md. a copy of the training manual was shown to all members. A short discussion followed on the topics of training, which was comprehensive. Chair Milligan advised that all those that completed the training would be compensated, per diem but an expense form would be required.

- Mr. Beery asked a question on the Open Meeting Act requirement, and Mr. Mohn said that he would check and report back on what was needed.
- Chair Milligan raised a question on secure communications between members, as we would deal with sensitive information. A discussion on use of County email followed. Mr. Mohn stated that he would look into it for ACC members.
- Chair Milligan stated that he expected to receive the first agency case very soon. He would advise ACC members, when it was received. The ACC will have 30 days from receipt to render a decision.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
