**General Items Discussed or Shared:**

- Reviewed 8/11 Action Items
  
- Steve Chandlee shared the latest news on progress with the Master Plan. He is scheduled to have a meeting with Todd Mohn and Steve Cohoon (Public Works) to

discuss next steps. They have received a bid from Kimly-Horn that had various options depending on the scope definition. We discussed the role that BPAC could play in helping to develop a Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan.

- Leslie, Nancy and Steve shared their perspective on the takeaways from the 10/4/22 Eastern Shore Regional Meeting on Bike and Pedestrian initiatives. Nancy spoke to QAC initiatives at the meeting. We discussed how any joint eastern shore initiative should benefit all parties involved.
- Our team expressed our appreciation to Nancy's active support for our team over the years. Steve said he would act as our liaison for future meetings for now. He also encouraged us to attend the PRAB meetings as appropriate.
- Nancy discussed developmental projects impacting trails (Safe Harbor Church). I expressed concern regarding the Armored Storage Building proposal (Piney Creek/Nash Court in Chester, MD) adjacent to the Cross Island Trail within the Critical Area shoreline.
- This was our last meeting for 2022. We discussed preferences on meeting times for 2023. I am currently recommending moving to the second Wednesday (vs. Thursday) of the second month in each quarter. So first meeting in 2023 would tentatively be Wednesday 2/8/2023 at 7:00pm.
