

PUBLIC NOTICE

At their regular meeting held on Tuesday, March 26, 2019, The County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County adopted County Ordinance No. 18-11, with amendments, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Uses Allowed in Connection with High Commercial Uses in Queen Anne's County; FOR THE PURPOSE of amending the definition of "High Commercial Uses" in Chapter 18 App of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's county, Maryland to clarify that high speed diesel fuel pumps, truck parking, overnight vehicle parking, truck stops and travel plazas are not permitted in the High Commercial Use of convenience stores with gas pumps and gasoline stations. BY AMENDING the definition of High Commercial Uses in Chapter 18 App: Appendix a; Glossary of the Code of Public Local Laws.

This Act shall take effect on the 46<sup>th</sup> day following its passage.
