

PUBLIC NOTICE

At their regular meeting held on Tuesday, June 11, 2019, The County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County adopted County Ordinance No. 19-11, AN EMERGENCY BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING the Establishment of a Tax Credit Against County Property Tax on Certain Real Property Owned by Volunteer Fire Department Members. FOR THE PURPOSE of establishing a tax credit against County property tax on certain real property owned by Volunteer Fire Department Members in Queen Anne's County, establishing eligibility requirements for such tax credits and the amount, terms and conditions of the credit; and generally dealing with real property tax credits in Queen Anne's County, Maryland. BY ENACTING a new Section 5-10.7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

This Emergency Bill took effect immediately following its passage.
