

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 12-08

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Membership and Composition of the Emergency Services Advisory Council;

FOR THE PURPOSE of revising the membership and composition of the Emergency Services Advisory Council established under Chapter 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County to include five (5) “consumer” members, four of whom shall reside in and represent the four County Commissioner Districts in Queen Anne’s County and one of whom shall be an “at large” consumer member; to include a nonvoting member who shall be a hospital representative; and generally revising and addressing the membership and composition of the Emergency Services Advisory Council in Queen Anne’s County;

BY AMENDING Section 21-12 B. (2) and (3) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County by amending Subsection 21-12 B. (2) (j) and adding Subsection 21-12 B. (3) (e).

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 21-12 B. (2) and (3) of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended to read as follows:

§21-12. Emergency Services Advisory Council.

...

B. Membership.

...

(2) ...

(j) Consumers ~~(four)~~ (five, four of whom shall reside in and represent each of the four County Commissioners Districts in Queen Anne’s County and one of whom shall be an at-large member who may reside anywhere in the County).

(3) ...

(e) A representative of a licensed hospital.

...

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
