

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on February 28, 2012, Commissioner Olds introduced County Ordinance No. 12-06, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Recognition of English as The Official Language in Queen Anne's County. FOR THE PURPOSE of designating the English language as the official language of Queen Anne's County; BY ADDING Section 4-14 to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County.
