

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 11-23

AN EMERGENCY BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Correction of Certain Typographical Errors in County Ordinance No. 11-19 Describing County Commission Election Districts;

FOR THE PURPOSE of correcting the general descriptions of County Commissioner Election Districts 3 and 4 as contained in County Ordinance No. 11-19;

BY AMENDING Sections 4-2A(3) and (4) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Sections 4-2.A.(3) and (4) be amended to read as follows:

§4-2. Districts. Redistricting Board.

A. Districts. . . .

. . .

(3) District 3 is comprised of Grasonville, Kent Narrows, Chester, and part of the Stevensville area. This district is bordered on the west east by Walsey Creek to US 50 to Nesbit Road to Main Street to Bennett Point Road to Governors Way to the Wye River, to the north by the Chester River, to the south by Eastern Bay and to the east west by Cox Creek to US 50 to Love Point Road to Old Love Point Road to Benton Road to the Chester River and is specifically described by reference to the following Election District Precincts:

**Election District 4, Precincts 2, 4 & 7
Election District 5, Precincts 2 & 3**

(4) District 4 is comprised of Stevensville and Romancoke and is bordered on the east west by the Chesapeake Bay, to the south by Eastern Bay, to the west east by the Eastern Bay and Cox Creek to US 50 to Love Point Road to Old Love Point Road to Benton Road to the Chester River, and to the north by the Chester River and is specifically

described by referenced to the following Election District Precincts:

Election District 4, Precincts 1, 3, 5 & 6

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act be and is deemed to be an
Emergency Bill affecting the health, safety and welfare of the County and shall
take effect from the date of its passage.**
