

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on June 23, 2020, Commissioner J. Wilson introduced County Ordinance No. 20-04, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Accessory Dwelling Unit Provisions in the Resource Conservation Area FOR THE PURPOSE of making accessory dwelling unit provisions as outlined in both Maryland Natural Resources Annotated Code Section 8-1808.1 and COMAR 27.01.02.05. consistent with the development standards in resource conservation area and the dwelling unit definition found in the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland. BY ADDING §14:1-39.B.(2). Development standards in resource conservation and AMENDING §18App. Definition of Dwelling Unit found in the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.
