

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on July 12, 2011, Commissioner Dunmyer introduced County Ordinance No. 11-08, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Revisions to Chapter 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County entitled "Construction Regulations: Electrical Examiners"; FOR THE PURPOSE of revising and updating Chapter 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws, defining certain terms and revising the definition of certain other terms; clarifying the applicability of the provision of Chapter 11 to Restricted Electricians; providing the Board of Electrical Examiners ("Board") shall have the authority to establish fees for electrical permits subject to approval of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County; establishing experience requirements for restricted licenses; requiring requests to be made in writing to the Board; providing for Temporary Licenses; supplementing the provisions regarding the term and conditions on licensure; providing for display of licenses issued; providing for license renewal; making provisions for the death of a licensed Master Electrician; clarifying applicable Code Standards; regulating electrical inspections and inspectors and providing the Board with certain authority with respect thereto; and establishing procedures in the event of termination of a licensed electrician; BY AMENDING provisions of Chapter 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, August 23, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.

Speakers will be limited to three minutes each. Written testimony of any length may be submitted on or before the hearing date to the County Commissioners, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland 21617.
