

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 10-07

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING a Minor Revision to County Commissioner District 1 and District 2.

FOR THE PURPOSE of moving part of Census Block Group 810500 Group 2 from County Commissioner District 2 to County Commissioner District 1 to have the County Commissioner Districts correspond with the Election Precincts in Queen Anne's County.

BY AMENDING Section 4.2.A. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 4.2.A. of Chapter 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County be amended to read as follows:

§ 4-2. Districts; Redistricting Board. [Amended 2-19-2002 by Ord. No. 01-08]

A. Districts. The County shall be divided into four County Commissioners election districts in accordance with this section until modified by the Redistricting Board as hereinafter provided.

(1) District 1 is comprised of the northern area of the County, including the Church Hill, Sudlersville, Kingstown, Barclay and Crumpton areas, and the eastern part of the County, including the Ruthsburg area, and is specifically described by reference to the 2000 U.S. Census Bureau data as the following Census Block Groups:

- (a) 810100 All groups.**
- (b) 810200 All groups.**
- (c) 810300 All groups.**
- (d) 810500 Group 1.**
- (e) 810500 Group 2 - Blocks 2043, 2045 and 2046 only.**

(2) District 2 is comprised of the Centreville and Queenstown areas, including the area east of Bennett Point Road from Maryland Route 18 to the intersection of Perry's Corner Road and the entire southern part of Bennett Point Road and the Prospect Bay communities, and is specifically described by reference to the 2000 U.S. Census Bureau data as the following Census Block

Groups:

- (a) 810400 All groups.
- (b) 810500 Group 2 - Excepting Blocks 2043, 2045 and 2046.
- (c) 810600 All groups.

(3) District 3 is comprised of the Grasonville area of the County as well as Kent Island north of U.S. Route 50 and south of U.S. Route 50 east of Maryland Route 552, south of Pollard Lane and Newton Road and east of Crab Alley Creek and is specifically described by reference to the 2000 U.S. Census Bureau data as the following Census Block Groups:

- (a) 810700 All groups.
- (b) 810800 All groups.
- (c) 811000 Group 2.

(4) District 4 is comprised of Kent Island south of U.S. Route 50 and west of Crab Alley Creek as well as the area west of Maryland Route 552 north of Pollard Lane and Newtown Road to U.S. Route 50, includes all of the Route 8 area south of U.S. Route 50 and is specifically described by reference to the 2000 U.S. Census Bureau data as the following Census Block Groups:

- (a) 810900 All groups.
- (b) 811000 Group 1.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
