

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on Tuesday, June 9, 2009 Commissioner Wargotz introduced County Ordinance No. 09-15, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING the Storage of Residential Refuse in Queen Anne's County; FOR THE PURPOSE of requiring the safe and sanitary storage of household refuse in Queen Anne's County; requiring that such refuse be securely stored in acceptable containers and disposed of properly; and providing penalties for violation of these provisions. BY ADDING new Subsections 19-3 C., D. and E. to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland. Amendment No. 1 to the proposed Ordinance was adopted on June 29, 2008 which provides an exemption from the foregoing requirements for bona fide composting of organic waste.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance as amended on Tuesday, July 28, 2009 at 7:05 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.

Speakers will be limited to three minutes each. Written testimony of any length may be submitted on or before the hearing date to the County Commissioners, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland 21617.
