RESOLUTION NO. 11-10  
(Proposal 1a)

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY SITTING AS THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY SANITARY COMMISSION TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL RATE ADJUSTMENT FOR SEWER RATES IN ALL SUBDISTRICTS IN THE COUNTY FROM 2.5% TO 6.5% TO CONTRIBUTE TO PAYING THE ANNUAL DEBT SERVICE FOR THE NEW ENHANCED NUTRIENT REMOVAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND FUND DEPRECIATION OF ALL SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE ASSETS.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County have received and reviewed an assessment of Sewer and Water rates conducted by Springsted, Inc. and have solicited public comment and recommendations of the Queen Anne's County Public Works Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, certain proposed revisions to the sewer and water rate schedules for the Queen Anne's County Sanitary District have been duly advertised and a public hearing conducted on April 12, 2011.

AND WHEREAS, after due review and consideration, the following change to the existing Water and Wastewater Subdistrict Rate Schedule has been approved.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND, SITTING AS THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY SANITARY COMMISSION as follows:


The user rates for wastewater as established in the existing rate schedules for all subdistricts shall annually on July 1 increase by 6.5% unless the County Commissioners shall determine by resolution prior to July 1 of each year that the rates will increase by a lesser percentage.






