



**QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY STATE OF
EMERGENCY OR PROCLAMATION
DECLARATION**

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in Queen Anne's County for a period of time beginning at 1800 hours on the date of February 5, 2010 and continuing in effect for a period not to exceed seven (7) days and ending at 1800 hours on the date of February 12, 2010

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by: a major snow storm with the potential of more than 24 inches of snow and predicted blizzard conditions. Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of Queen Anne's County.

As President of the County Commissioners, Queen Anne's County, I Gene M. Ransom, III, Esq., have exercised the authority given to me under the Annotated Code of Maryland, Article 16A, Section 6c, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Community.

I hereby direct the Department (s) of Emergency Services to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
