A RESOLUTION RESPECTING THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY IN AND NEAR THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, Maryland ("the County") have determined that a parcel of land and improvements known as 306 Church Street, Stevensville, Maryland and more particularly described in a deed to the County dated March 1, 1995 and recorded in Liber S.M. No. 488, folio 586 of the Land Records of Queen Anne's County, Maryland ("the property") is no longer needed for public purposes and that it would be advantageous to the public interest to transfer the same to The Queen Anne's County Housing Authority for such Housing Authority's use in providing workforce housing in the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND this 9th day of March, 2010 as follows:

1. The property and the transfer of same to the Queen Anne's County Housing Authority, without consideration, be and is hereby approved.
2. Notice of this action shall be published in one or more newspapers of general circulation in Queen Anne's County once a week for three successive weeks stating the terms under which the property will be disposed of, the compensation to be received therefore and providing the public the opportunity for objections thereto.
