

PUBLIC NOTICE

At their regular meeting held on Tuesday, August 19, 2008 the County Commissioners adopted the following County Ordinances:

08-11 as amended: AN ACT CONCERNING the Implementation of Design Standards for Development in the Urban Commercial (UC) and Town Center (TC) Districts in Queen Anne's County; FOR THE PURPOSE of implementing the recommendations of the Chester/Stevensville Community Plan with respect to design standards for development in the UC and TC zoning districts in Queen Anne's County and providing that such Act shall apply to development applications filed on or after July 10, 2008.

08-15 as amended: AN ACT CONCERNING Minor Extraction and Dredge Disposal Uses in Queen Anne's County; FOR THE PURPOSE of providing that minor extraction and disposal uses are a permitted use in the Agricultural (AG) District if such use does not require a surface mining permit or is located on a parcel that has not been subject to a cluster subdivision or is a developed parcel for noncontiguous development but may be located in required open space of a transferor parcel and providing that minor extraction and dredge disposal uses are a conditional use if such use requires a surface mining permit or is located on a parcel that has been subject to cluster subdivision or is a developed parcel for noncontiguous development or is located within required open space of cluster and noncontiguous development.

08-18 AN ACT CONCERNING a Property Tax Credit for Dwelling Owned by Spouse of Fallen, or by Disabled, Law Enforcement Officer or Rescue Worker. FOR THE PURPOSE of

granting a property tax credit under Section 9-210 of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland to the spouse of a fallen law enforcement officer or rescue worker and to a disabled law enforcement officer or rescue worker; BY ADDING a new Section 5-10.2 to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County.

Each of these Acts shall take effect on the 46th day following its passage.
