

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 07-01

AN AMENDMENT TO
A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING Boards and Commissions in Queen Anne's
County;

FOR THE PURPOSE OF amending pending County Ordinance 07-01
to clarify the applicability of the minimum attendance
requirements contained therein and to clarify the time frame in
which the attendance requirement is to be calculated.

BY AMENDING County Ordinance 07-01 to read as follows:

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S
COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 4-10 C. be added to the Code of
Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County to read as follows:

§ 4-10. County staff and appointments.

C. Same - Attendance. Any regular member of a Board or
Commission in Queen Anne's County who shall fail to attend at
least 80% of the regularly scheduled meetings of such Board or
Commission during each full twelve month period following
appointment shall be considered to have resigned from such Board
or Commission. The County Commissioners shall promptly appoint a
replacement to fill the unexpired term of any member so
resigning. Upon a written request the Commission may reappoint
the resigned member if good cause is shown and there is unanimous
agreement by the Board of Commissioners that the member be
reappointed.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Amendment shall take effect
immediately following its enactment.
