

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 07-36

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the rezoning of part of Parcel 68 on Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57.

FOR THE PURPOSE of rezoning part of Parcel No. 68 on Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57 from Chester Master-Planned Development (CMPD) District to Countryside (CS) District.

BY AMENDING Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that approximately 48.4 acres, part of Parcel 68 on Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57 be and is hereby rezoned from Chester Master-Planned Development (CMPD) District to Countryside (CS) District. The area hereby rezoned is more particularly shown by reference to the proposed new official Zoning Map 57.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its passage.

Legislation Title: Rezoning of part of Parcel 68

Description:

The purpose of this legislation is to rezone part of Parcel 68 from Chester Master-Planned Development (CMPD) District to Countryside (CS) District.

Analysis of Fiscal Impact:

This legislation itself produces no significant fiscal impact, as it is simply an amendment to County Sectional Zoning Map 57. The property tax on the property may increase or decrease as a result of the re-zoning, but until such time as the property is re-assessed under its new zoning, the impact on property tax revenue cannot be accurately estimated.
