

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 07-39

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the rezoning of Parcels 25 and 377 on Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57.

FOR THE PURPOSE of rezoning Parcel Nos. 25 and 377 on Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57 from Chester Master-Planned Development (CMPD) District to Neighborhood Conservation - 15 (NC-15) District.

BY AMENDING Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Parcels 25 and 377 on Queen Anne's County Sectional Zoning Map 57 be and is hereby rezoned from Chester Master-Planned Development (CMPD) District to Neighborhood Conservation - 15 (NC-15) District.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its passage.

Legislation Title: Rezoning of Parcels 25 and 377

Description:

The purpose of this legislation is to rezone Parcels 25 and 377 from Chester Master-Planned Development (CMPD) District to Neighborhood Conservation - 15 (NC-15) District.

Analysis of Fiscal Impact:

This legislation itself produces no significant fiscal impact, as it is simply an amendment to County Sectional Zoning Map 57. The property tax on the property may increase or decrease as a result of the re-zoning, but until such time as the property is re-assessed under its new zoning, the impact on property tax revenue cannot be accurately estimated.
