WHEREAS, State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Neighborhood Conservation Initiative (NCI) Program: and

WHEREAS, a requirement of the application is the receipt of a support resolution from the legislative body where the application activities would take place; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Queen Anne's County Commissioners are supportive of the application to be submitted by The Queen Anne's County Department of Housing and Community Services in the amount of \$2,000,000. for the following activities: (1) To increase affordable workforce housing opportunities in neighborhoods most affected by foreclosure in coordination with local partners; and (2) To maximize revitalization and stabilization impact in target "Conservation" neighborhoods, focusing and coordinating investment of local and State resources; and (3) To complement ongoing foreclosure prevention activities of State and local partners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the president of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the submission of the application.
