

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 06-27

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING Oath Provisions for the Queen Anne s County Ethics Commission.

FOR THE PURPOSE of authorizing the Queen Anne s County Ethics Commission to administer oath and affirmatives;

BY AMENDING Section 8-10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne s County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE S COUNTY, MARYLAND that a new Section 8-10 I. be added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne s County and that present Sections 8-10 I. and J. be redesignated accordingly, as follows:

I. Oaths.

(1) The Commission may administer oaths and affirmations.

J. ~~J.~~ The Commission may grant exemptions and modifications to the provisions of this chapter as provided in § 8-15.

K. ~~J.~~ The Commission may develop and publish rules, regulations, and reporting forms in order to carry out the provisions of this chapter; provided, however, that, prior to the issuance of such rules, regulations, or forms, the Commission notifies the Board of County Commissioners and the public through appropriate means and affords the public no less than 14 days within which to comment on such proposed rules, regulations, and forms.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Bill shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its passage.
