

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 05-16

AN AMENDMENT TO
A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Establishment of a Continuing County Residency Requirement for Appointment to or Service on County Boards and Commissions;

FOR THE PURPOSE of providing an exception to the requirements in pending County Ordinance 05-16 that all persons appointed to Boards and Commissions by the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County shall be residents of the County at the time of appointment and that such persons shall not continue service on any such Board or Commission upon relinquishing residency in Queen Anne's County.

BY AMENDING pending County Ordinance 05-16.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 4-10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland shall be amended to read as follows:

'4-10. County staff and appointments.

A. Staff

Except as otherwise provided by law, the County Commissioners may provide for the appointment and removal of County officers and employees and set their compensation.

B. Board and Commissions.

No person shall be appointed by the County Commissioners to any Board or Commission in the County unless such person is a resident of Queen Anne's County and any person so appointed shall, upon relinquishing his residency in Queen Anne's County, be considered to have resigned from such Board or Commission. The foregoing provisions shall not apply to any person whose membership on a Board or Commission is required by governmental law, rule or regulation or by virtue of such person's employment or position.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Amendment shall take effect

immediately upon its passage.
