I. SCOPE

- A. This standard applies to all Queen Anne's County Fire Department's.

II. PURPOSE

- A. To establish standards for a Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) Bag.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

- A. All Queen Anne's County Fire Department's will be responsible for ensuring strict adherence to this standard.

IV. STANDARD

- A. One (1) RIT bag shall be carried on the departments first run Engine meeting the Class A Engine Standard, to include Engine-Tankers and Rescue-Engines.
 - 1. "Per Standard 02.06 Rapid Intervention Team, under Procedure letter G, the fourth arriving engine will assume the RIT responsibilities. The Incident Commander has the discretion to assign other types of units and can designate the RIT responsibilities to any unit at any time."
 - 2. Recommend a RIT Bag be carried on special service (Rescues, Aerial Apparatus) also.

B. Minimum required equipment to be carried in or on the bag.

1. One (1) 60-minute SCBA cylinder.
2. One (1) SCBA face mask with mask mounted regulator.
3. One (1) high pressure fill whip with a URC connector, minimum of five (5) feet in length.
4. One (1) low pressure line, minimum of five (5) feet in length.
5. One (1) pair wire/cable cutters
6. One (1) strobe type light mounted on exterior of bag.
7. Two hundred (200) feet of search line. 6.8mm to 9mm size line is recommend.
