Dem Tech is a Virginia based company with offices throughout the country. Chrissy will be attending Election Day on Tuesday, Nov 2, 2021 in Loudon County, Virginia to see these pollbooks being implemented.
 - a. Our current pollbooks (EPB5000) will be used for the 2022 elections, these were built originally in 1996 and implemented by the state in 2006.
- C. Redistricting is still going on and current potential changes could affect the northern end of Queen Anne's County.
