

**A BILL ENTITLED**

96-10

AN ACT CONCERNING the Repeal and Re-enactment with Amendments of Title 10, Section 10-107 of the Code of the Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County (Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland).

FOR THE PURPOSE of revising provisions respecting membership of the Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board and establishing the composition and terms of the members of the Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board.

**SECTION I.** BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Code of the Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Section 10-107 is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

**10-107. Plumbing Board.**

The County Commissioners shall appoint a County Plumbing Board which shall consist of five (5) members made up of two (2) representatives of the Master Plumbers Association of Queen Anne's County and three (3) ~~persons~~ not connected with plumbing or the building trade. Initially, the County Commissioners shall appoint two (2) members for one (1) year terms, two (2) members for two (2) year terms and one (1) member for a three (3) year term. Thereafter all members shall be appointed for three (3) years terms or until the successor be duly appointed.

The Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board shall meet at least once a month at the office of the Plumbing Board or such other place as may be designated by the Board. In addition to the other duties hereinafter set forth it shall hear and decide all questions in dispute between property owners, or their agents, and the plumbing inspector. Said County Plumbing Board shall also act as advisor to the County Commissioners with respect to the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this law. Any person, firm or corporation aggrieved by the decision of the County Plumbing Board may appeal to the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's County.

**SECTION II.** BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day after its adoption.
