- Is the Standard Erosion and Sediment Control Plan for Forest Harvest Operations attached?
- Is a FCA Declaration of Intent signed by the property owner attached?

Note: For a commercial harvest in E, SE, SR, NC, UR, SC, US, SI, LIHS, VC, SHVC, GNC, or AD, Board of Appeals approval is **required**. A Forest Management Plan is also **required**. Contact a planner in the Planning Department at (410) 758-1255.
