**Erosion and Sediment Control
Right of Entry Agreement**

As authorized in Section 14:2-16 of the Queen Anne's County Code, in the event the permittee(s) of the grading permit issued pursuant to the accompanying application is (are) notified in writing that a violation of the terms and conditions of the grading permit has occurred, Queen Anne's County is hereby granted the right to enter onto the property, which is the subject of the application, in order to abate the violation. The permittee shall be responsible for the costs incurred by Queen Anne's County to abate the violation. The costs, if unpaid by the permittee or its surety, may be collected by the County in the same manner that unpaid property taxes are collected.

Permittee and Queen Anne's County agree that any access to the construction site shall be accompanied by a representative of the permittee, and that any agent acting on behalf of Queen Anne's County shall be required to wear, upon entry to site, appropriate personal protective equipment as required by permittee's safety policies. If the permittee does not make a representative available within 24 hours of notice of the County's intent to enter the property, the County may proceed to abate the violation without the presence of such a representative.
