WHEREAS, Queen Anne's County wishes to promote business development and job creation at locations in the county to capture the related economic benefit through expansion of the tax base; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Job Creation Tax Credit Program has been made available to Queen Anne's County to provide a tax credit to businesses that create a minimum of 60 new jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Job Creation Tax Credit Program is available to businesses located in Designated Priority Funding Areas; and


WHEREAS, the County designated a specific Priority Funding Area for inclusion in the Job Creation Tax Credit program, businesses in that area will be able to take advantage of the credits with a reduced threshold of 25 new jobs created; and


WHEREAS, while future business development is anticipated throughout the county, the most opportune sites for large-scale job creation are in the Stevensville, Chester, and Kent Narrows areas.


