A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND

WHEREAS, Queen Anne's County, ("the County") pursuant to Environmental Article, Section 9-1712 is required to amend its Solid Waste Management Plan to include a mandatory special event recycling plan; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to promote sound and ecologically-friendly solid waste management practices which give due consideration to the future solid waste requirements of the County; and


WHEREAS, a public hearing was held with respect to the proposed amendment on September 8, 2015.
