

SENSITIVE SPECIES PROJECT REVIEW AREAS (SSPRA) PRIMARILY REPRESENTS THE GENERAL LOCATIONS OF DOCUMENTED RARE, THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES AS CREATED AND UPDATED BY STAFF OF THE WILDLIFE AND HERITAGE SERVICE.

NATIONAL WETLANDS INVENTORY (NWI) INCLUDES WETLANDS AS IDENTIFIED BY THE US FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICE DATASETS. TYPICALLY THESE INCLUDE WETLANDS THAT ARE 5 ACRES OR LARGER IN SIZE, ADDITIONAL WETLANDS MAY EXIST.
