

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on January 24, 2017, Commissioner J. Wilson introduced County Ordinance No. 17-03, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Revisions to the Queen Anne's County Human Resources Ordinance, Chapter 27 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland; FOR THE PURPOSE of revising and updating the Queen Anne's County Human Resources Ordinance, including Sections 27-91D, 27-30, 27-93 and 27-91B(3)(e) of Chapter 27 of the Code of Public Local Laws, revising provisions on bereavement leave, hazardous duty assignment, employee recognition and family sick leave; and generally eliminating the requirement that bereavement leave be used in a consecutive block of time; deleting obsolete and unutilized provisions on hazardous duty assignment; eliminating exemplary attendance records from the provisions for employee recognition; and clarifying the definitions of "spouse", "child" and "parent" for purpose of family sick leave.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, February 28, 2017 at 6:35 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.

Speakers will be limited to three minutes each. Written testimony of any length may be submitted on or before the hearing date to the County Commissioners, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland 21617.
