

AMENDMENT NO 1 TO  
COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 16-15

AN AMENDMENT TO  
A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING Revisions to the Criteria for Major and  
Minor Extraction Operations;

FOR THE PURPOSE of amending pending County Ordinance No.  
16-15 to incorporate the recommendations of the Queen Anne's  
County Planning Commission; eliminating the deletion of the  
definition of "Minor Extraction and Dredge Disposal Uses" and  
the addition of a definition for "Dredge Disposal Uses";  
limiting the number of minor extractions permitted per lot and  
prohibiting expansion of minor extraction through Administrative  
Subdivision of a lot for a period of five years from permitting;  
prohibiting hydraulic dredges, wash plants and large excavators  
in connections with minor extraction:

BY AMENDING pending County Ordinance No. 16-15:

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S  
COUNTY, MARYLAND that pending County Ordinance No. 16-15 be and  
is hereby amended by DELETING Section II thereof.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that pending County Ordinance No. 16-  
15 be and is hereby amended by deleting Section III thereof and  
substituting the following amendment to Section 18:1-95 F. of  
the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County:

§18:1-95.F. Minor extraction.

- (1) Minor extraction includes sand, gravel, or similar  
extraction and clean fill storage operations.  
One minor extraction per lot shall be permitted.  
Further expansion for each additional minor extraction  
or a second minor extraction on the same lot or  
through Administrative Subdivision of the same lot  
within five years of the date that the minor

extraction permit is issued shall be prohibited.

(g) Hydraulic dredges, wash plants and large excavators shall be prohibited.

SECTION III

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Amendment shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
