

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 14-05

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Applicability of the Queen Anne's County Human Resources Ordinance to certain Employees of the Queen Anne's County Sheriff's Department and certain State Agencies;

FOR THE PURPOSE of clarifying the applicability of the Queen Anne's County Human Resources Ordinance to certain employees; adding employees of the Sheriff of Queen Anne's County and employees on the Queen Anne's County payroll working for various state agencies to those employees exempt from certain provisions of this Chapter;

BY AMENDING Section 27-11 of Chapter 27. Human Resources of the Code of Public Local Law of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 27-11 of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended to read as follows:

Chapter 27. HUMAN RESOURCES

Article III. Exempt Service and State Employees

§27-11. Application of Human Resources Ordinance.

The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to members of the exempt service except as follows.

- A. Employees of the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's County shall:
(1) Be subject to the provisions of Articles VIII, ~~IX~~, X, and XIV.
(2) Serve under the direct supervision and at the pleasure of the County Administrative Judge.**
- B. Employees of the State's Attorney for Queen Anne's County shall:
(1) Be subject to the provisions of Articles VIII, ~~IX~~, X, and XIV
(2) Serve under the direct supervision and at the pleasure of the State's Attorney of Queen Anne's County.**
- C. Deputy Sheriffs and employees working in the office of the Sherriff**

Department for Queen Anne's County shall:

(1) Be subject to the provisions of Articles VIII, IX, X, XIV, and all sections of Article VII except §§ 27-72 and 27-80.

(2) Serve under the direct supervision of the Sherriff of Queen Anne's County in accordance with the Maryland state law.

D. Employees on the Queen Anne's County payroll who work for the Queen Anne's County Department of Social Services, Department of Health, Extension Office and Soil Conservations shall:

(1) Be subject to the provisions of Articles VII, I and XIV

(2) Serve under the direct supervisions of the respective agency Directors

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its adoption.
